# Some Tips and Tricks

- White on a dark background is easier to read than black on a light background
- Add a transparent background to the text if needed
  - Right click on text box
  - Choose Format Placeholder
  - Choose a color for the background
  - Choose a transparency percentage that allows the words to be read but does not hide the slide background

# Tips and Tricks continued

- Use bold 32 or 36 point font for words that are to be said in unison
- Use a smaller font italicized (24 point) for non-reading information
- To superscript verse numbers in the scripture reading
  - Highlight number
  - Choose Format - Font - check superscript

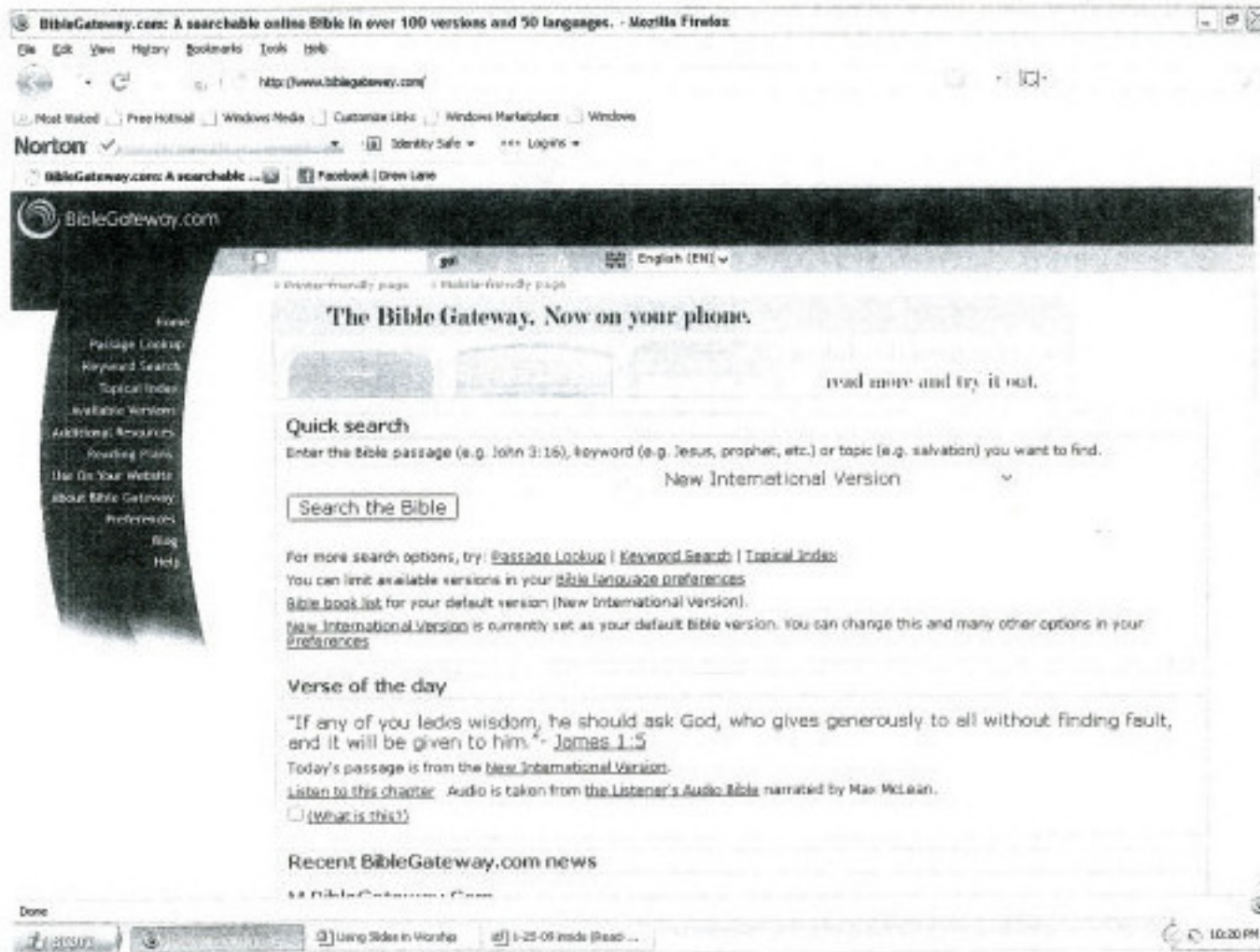
